

Volunteer Position: Director Board Position

Mission of the Director:

The mission of the Director is to manage the affairs of the Chapter.

Volunteer Contribution:

The Director serves on the Board of Directors along with Chapter officers. Each Director participates as a board liaison to one of the Chapter committees.

Estimated Time Commitment:

At a minimum, 1.5 hours per month during Chapter board meetings.

Approximately 1–2 hours a month to complete duties.

There are four Directors; two Directors are alternatively elected each year for two-year terms.

Responsibilities

- Attend and participate in monthly Board meetings
- Manage and control the property, affairs, and business of the Chapter
- Participate as a voting member during Board meetings to decide on matters pertinent to the Chapter
- Volunteer on one Chapter committee during term

Professional Development:

- Increased Knowledge of Association Management, Operations and Governance
- Leadership Skills
- Organizational and Management Skills

Requirements:

- To be eligible for Director the individual must have served on a committee for one year
- Must be an active SMPS CT member
- Ability to attend all monthly Board meetings
